Coppa d'Europa 2026

As already announced, we will be making some minor changes for the 20th Coppa. In consideration of the advanced age of many participants (including ourselves), the rally days will be slightly shorter. It starts with the fact that we will only start from 08.00 a.m. every day....

We cross parts of the Netherlands, Belgium, Germany, Luxembourg and France on beautiful, selective and exciting routes. In addition to interesting navigation tasks, as you are used to from us and for which we are known, some tests and a large number of challenging regularity sections await you.

You won't get bored and our usual high quality will certainly inspire you.

As in previous years, we can already reveal that the starting point will be Maastricht. Our first overnight stay will be in Saarbrücken, the second in Pforzheim and the finish, with the award ceremony and last overnight stay, will be in Aalen.

Of course, all overnight stays will be in top-class hotels.

Map reading systems

As many of you will be aware, we organise our events using a wide variety of map reading and orientation systems. Over the years, it has become apparent that fewer and fewer historical rallies are being organised that offer the 'old school of map reading systems'.
